**LAKE CHAMPLAIN CHAMBER MUSIC FESTIVAL, LED BY ARTISTIC DIRECTOR SOOVIN KIM, TO PERFORM WINTER CONCERTS AT ELLEY LONG MUSIC CENTER, COLCHESTER, VT, AND E. GLENN GILTZ AUDITORIUM IN PLATTSBURGH, NY.**

The Lake Champlain Chamber Music Festival returns with a Winter Series to build on the success of its inaugural summer festival – one concert on each side of Lake Champlain. Internationally-renowned violinist, and Plattsburgh native, Soovin Kim heads up the Festival as Artistic Director. Soovin ignited the classical music world when he won first prize at the Paganini International Competition at only 20 years old. He was later named the recipient of the Henryk Szeryng Career Award, an Avery Fisher Career Grant, and the Borletti-Buitoni Trust Award. He has found many friends among the most exciting players today – friends he continues to bring back to the community which nourished him early on as a young violinist with the Vermont Youth Orchestra.

Soovin spent much of his childhood in the Champlain Valley in Plattsburgh, NY. He joined the Vermont Youth Orchestra as its then-youngest member at age 10, and later served as its concertmaster for three years. He is often heard in the Champlain Valley through his performances with the VYO, the Vermont Symphony, on the Lane Series at the University of Vermont, at Middlebury College, and on Vermont Public Radio. He plays the 1709 *ex-Kempner* Stradivarius.
